Geography/ICT Can you research a Mayan city? What can you find out about it? What was it like? Write a fact file about it!	6 Strands Challenge - Being Responsible Can you take responsibility for completing a household chore for 1 week? Can you load/unload the dish washer, load the washing machine, hang the washing out on the line, put the washing away, lay the table or help cook dinner? Write a sentence about the chore you took responsibility for. Ask an adult to write a sentence about how successful you were.	Reading Read for pleasure; a range of texts, different genres, different authors, fiction and non-fiction. Can you read and share a story or poem we've never read before?
Get Creative The Mayan's loved chocolate. Think about your favourite chocolate treat? Design a wrapper for a new chocolate bar you have invented.	Writing What Mayan myths can you find out about? Retell the story in your own words!	Art Create your own Mayan headdress? Take a photo of you wearing it or bring it in to show your class.
Technology The Mayans were great farmers and enjoyed eating tortillas filled with cooked vegetables! Can you design your own Mayan tortilla recipe? Perhaps you could even make it and take a photo!	Maths Can you find out about the Mayan Number System? Make your own maths calculation using the Mayan number system. We might use it during our maths starter to see if anyone can crack it!	History Find out about the different Mayan gods? Can you draw a picture of what you think they looked like? Write about what you have found out.
