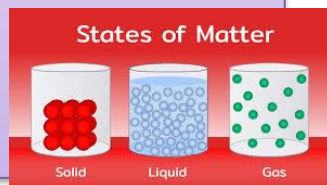


Welcome back! We hope you had an enjoyable summer. We will be starting the year looking at the Ancient Egyptians. The children came up with questions about this period of time that they would like the answers to and we have based their learning around these questions. Water Bottles
