Transition Taster Day – Friday 6th March 2020

The time is fast approaching for you and your child to decide which school they would like to attend from September 2021.

We think it is important for students to start thinking about transition early so that they are able to make an informed choice. As part of this we are inviting all Year 5 students in the Ryde Primary Cluster to our school for one day on **Friday 6th March 2020**.

This is a great opportunity for the students to familiarise themselves with the building and meet our staff and students. They will also take part in team building activities and a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) project.

Outline of the day

- Students should arrive via the Pellhurst Road entrance (by the Zebra Crossing) by 9:00am. Students will then make their way to the courts. Staff will be there to meet and greet the students and direct them where to go.
- They should wear their primary school PE kit, with their primary school jumper over the top.
- Students will have a 40-minute lunch break.
- At 2:15pm they will be dismissed from the Pellhurst Road gate.

Please provide students with a suitable packed lunch and a drink (preferably a water bottle they can refill). If they are in receipt of free school meals, please pre-book these with your primary school. They must be collected from your primary school on the morning of the 6th March.
