Seedlings / growing / flowers

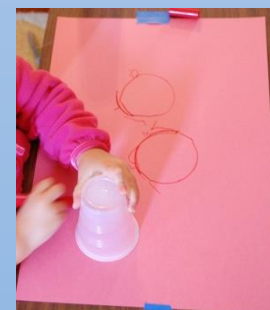
Maths
