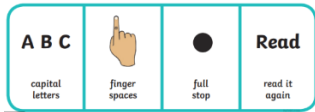
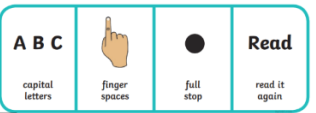

English—Reading/ Writing	Remember what you need to write a good sentence.  Can you write a sentence or two about something that you have seen when you have been on your daily walk or outside your window!	Read, retell or listen to the story of The Ugly Duckling. Do you like this story? What is your favourite part? Draw a picture and write a short sentence ... `My favourite part of the story is...`	Read, retell or listen to the story of The Ugly Duckling. Draw 6 pictures to show the life cycle of a duck or swan—put arrows in between them to make a life cycle diagram. Label each picture. 	Read, retell or listen to the story of The Ugly Duckling Draw a picture of the ugly duckling when he came out of the egg and a picture to show how he changed. Write a list of 3 words for each picture to describe how he felt at each different time. e.g. sad, ugly, lonely/happy, pretty ...	Read, retell or listen to the story of The Ugly Duckling Make your own little book using any paper you have at home— get a grown up to help you! Rewrite the story of the Ugly Duckling—draw some pictures too! Read your book to someone in your house!
Maths	Quick starter: Count form 1—20 both forwards and backwards!! Find 5 containers—and a random collection of items - about 20. Roll a dice—pick up the right number of items - put them in a container—have another go-use two dice-keep going until you have no items left! Add more items if you want to!	Quick starter: How many chairs are in your house? - have a look! Draw around both your hands—get your grown ups to do the same. Use these to measure some items around your house. Can you order your hand cut outs from small to big?	Quick starter: How many tins are in your food cupboard? Count and write! Play a board game with the people in your house. Use your whiteboard to keep the scores so you can work out who was the winner!	Quick starter: How many shoes are lying around in your house? Choose your favourite 5 numbers between 1 and 10. Write them on a piece of paper and stick up somewhere safe! Throw beanbags at the number target and record your score.	Quick Starter: order your 1—20 cards as quickly as you can! Use your lego or building bricks to make a tower taller than you and one smaller than you! Count the bricks in each one—write the number—can you find the difference between the two numbers!!
