Design and Technology / Art

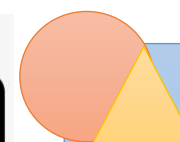
What can you find around your house and outside to build a boat? Can you test to see if it floats? Test it in the sink or bath or even outside in a puddle!
