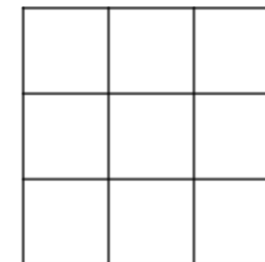
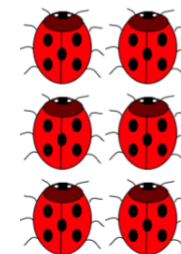
w/b 27th April: **TRUST**: Cat & Mouse pictures
