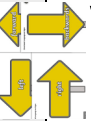

 Phonics	Bertie Bear is off on his travels ound the world this week, your lenges are linked to the places he visits! Every traveller needs a bag! Find or make a bag to be your phonics bag for this week. Using your sound card, copy out all of the sounds onto separate bits of paper, in particular the ones you don't know as well. Do the same for tricky words. Keep them in your bag and practise them throughout the week!	Practise all sounds and tricky words in your phonics bag! Today we are off to France! What language do they speak in France? Can you sound out the word for the language and write it on your whiteboard? It has 5 sounds. Can you write the English words for these things with sound buttons?   	Practise all sounds and tricky words in your phonics bag! Let's test your memory! Choose 6 objects in your house and lay them on the table. Have a good look before covering them with a tea towel. Ask a grown up to sneakily take one of the objects away—no peeking! Remove the tea towel, can you guess which one is missing? Challenge: Can you write down which item is missing on your whiteboard?	Practise all sounds and tricky words in your phonics bag! How many words can you think of with the 'ee' sound in? Write 10 of them down, twice on scrap pieces of paper and put them face down. Play 'pairs' with someone else. Turn two cards over at a time, read them out if you make a pair, you keep it! Take it in turns and see who wins with the most pairs! 	Practise all sounds and tricky words in your phonics bag! What can you see, hear, smell and taste? Can you make an Egyptian headpiece? It could be a head band or headdress—it should be bright and bold colours! Or an Egyptian fan! 
 Maths	All Aboard! Now that we've started our travels, we need to learn some directional language to help us navigate. Using a dice, play a game with another person. Practise left and right. Take it in turns to roll the dice and then give directions. E.g. if you land on a 2 give an instruction such as "move forwards 2 steps." or "Take 2 steps over the bridge" or "Take 2 steps to the right."	What is the time? Look at a clock. The little hand points to the hour it is. If the big hand is on 12 we say 'o'clock'. What time is it on these clocks?  In France, it is one hour later than the time it is on the Isle of Wight. Can you write what time it is at home if it was these times in France...	Counting in Spanish Can you remember how to count to 10 in Spanish? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=8ydJr1Is8xI Watch this video and have a practise! Ask a grown up to video yourself counting to 10 in Spanish and upload it to Tapestry or email it to the email address at the top of this page if you have trouble with it. 	 Pizza, Pizza! Italy is famous for it's amazing Pizzas! Can you create a pizza out of different shapes? You could draw it as a picture or cut the shapes out and stick them onto a pizza base. Try to use 4 different shapes. Can you talk to a grown up about the properties of the shape using the correct language. Name it. How many sides and corners?	Egyptian Pyramids! The Pyramids are a famous landmark in Egypt—they are huge! With a grown up have a look at them on the internet. Can you find some things around your house that are pyramid shaped?

- Can you put a M where you would find a Mcdonalds?

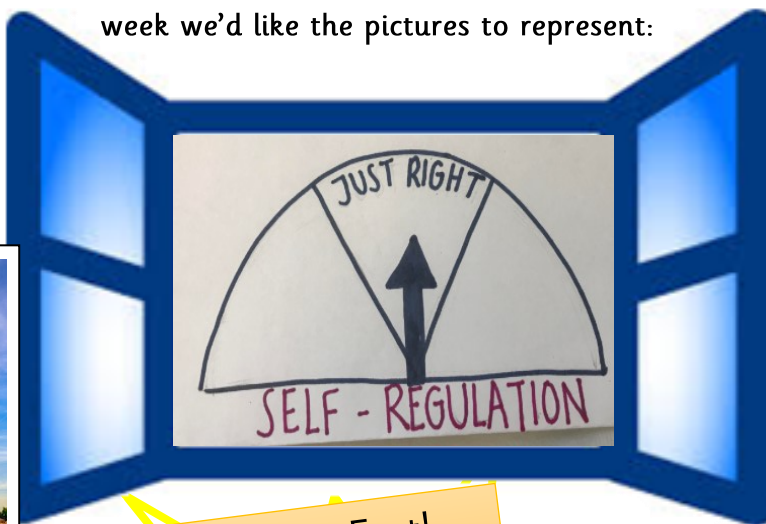

Display your pictures in your window! This week we'd like the pictures to represent:

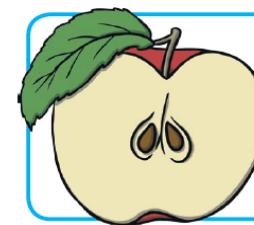


Isle of Wight Fact!

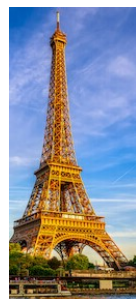
Cut up an apple into 8 slices. If you shared it equally between yourself and a friend, how many pieces would you have each?
