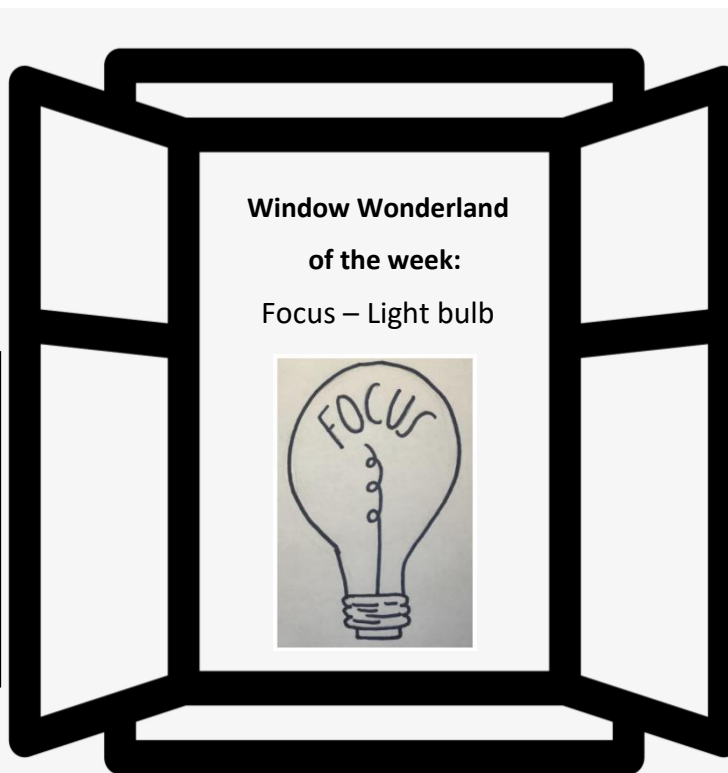
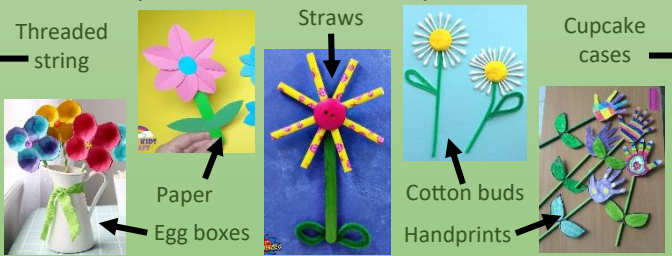
Can you write an acrostic poem using the word flower?

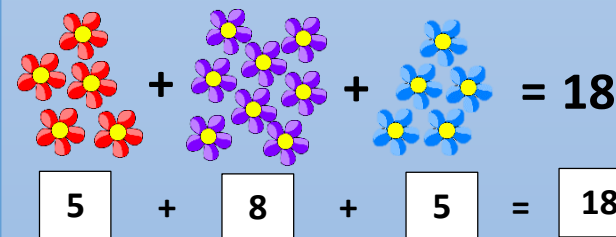
