Maths

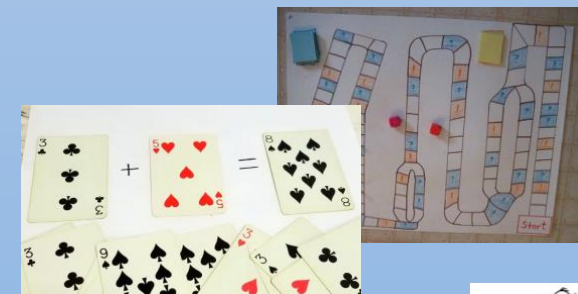


Can you make your own maths game?
