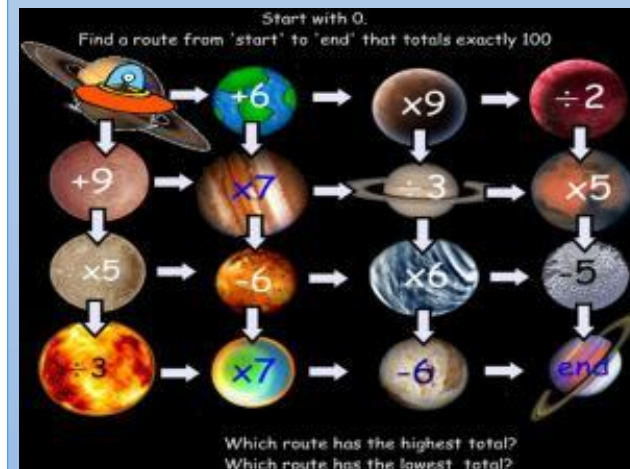
Cut out a kite shape from paper and decorate with ribbons and strings. Hang this from your window, gate or car and watch it move in the wind.
