

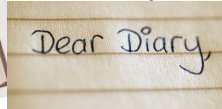
Below are some ideas of challenges for you to complete over the week. Please don't feel pressured to record or log any of them but we love to see pictures uploaded to Tapestry or your Key

Go on a litter pick or beach clean

You will need:

- an adult helper
 - a group of friends
(optional but useful!)
 - thick gardening gloves 
 - strong bin bags 
 - brightly coloured clothes
(for visibility near roads)
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- suitable footwear
(sturdy boots for rocky beaches)

Ask an adult to take you on a litter pick or beach clean.

Ask an adult if you're not sure whether to pick something up.

Things to avoid

- broken glass
- sharp objects
- dog poo bags
- anything dirty or dangerous
- large or heavy rubbish
- bottles of liquid



You could try separating litter into different bags for recycling.
