Riddle: At night they come out without being fetched, and by day they are lost without being stolen.

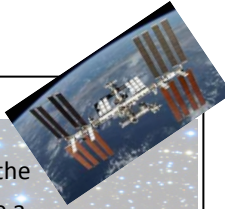
