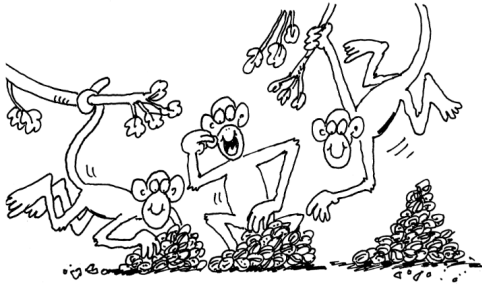

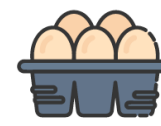


Science

RUBBER EGG EXPERIMENT

- Raw Eggs
- Household Vinegar
- Jar/Vase



Place an egg in a jar and cover with vinegar. Leave for 48 hours and remove the egg and rinse it off. What has happened? Shine a torch through the egg.

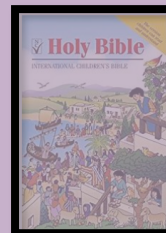


Treasure Hunt
