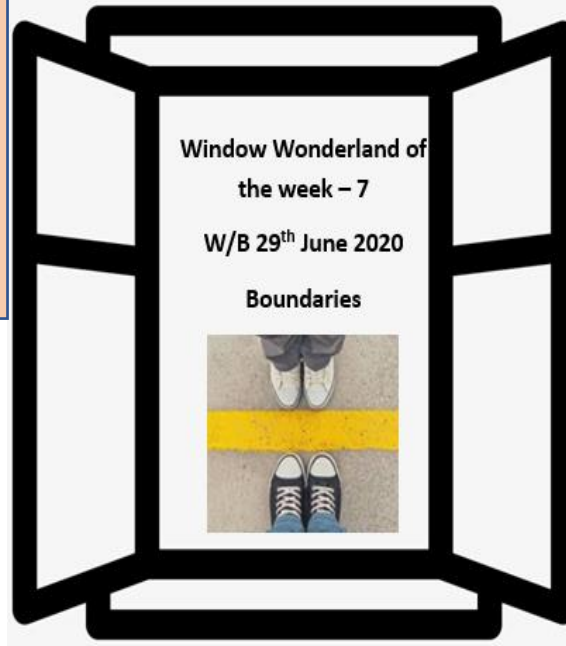
English
