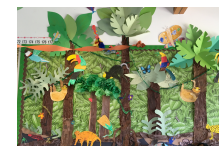
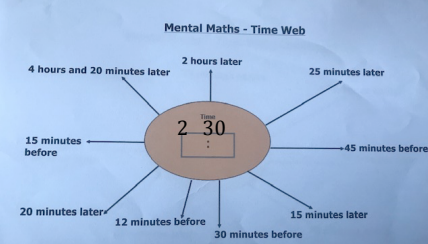
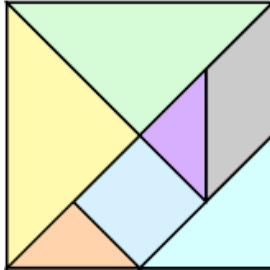

Some areas for you to research would be Mangroves and cloud forests. Produce a poster with facts and diagrams showing people what a jungle is and what it looks like. Remember your diagram will need to be labelled and your facts need a subheading. You could draw a picture of yourself as an explorer!	Close your eyes.
