Science Erupting Lemon Volcano

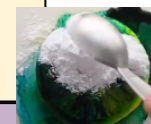
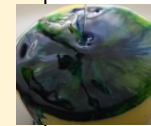
You will need: a lemon cut in half.

Food Colouring (not essential)

Bicarbonate of soda.

Washing up liquid.

1. Cut around the segments of the lemon.
2. Put 4 drops of colouring onto the lemon flesh.
3. Squirt over washing up liquid to cover the lemon flesh.
4. Add two heaped teaspoons of bicarbonate of soda.
5. Pour over 50ml of water and watch. You can poke the lemon and this creates the colour change.
