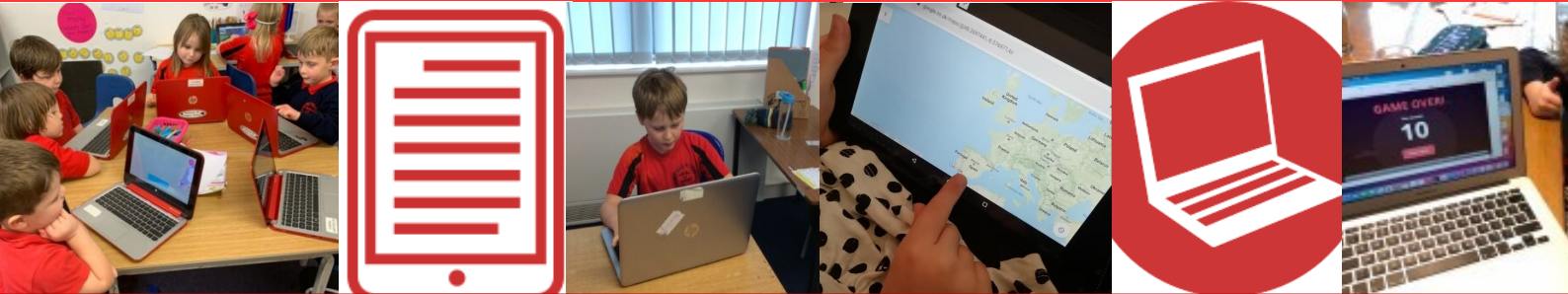




STAYING SAFE WITH REMOTE LEARNING

Due to the outbreak of the Coronavirus, schools may have to be closed in order to protect the safety of all. Whilst the internet and technology can really help us educate your child, it's crucially important that we ensure all children stay safe and are protected from online harm.



OUR TEACHERS WILL NEVER...

...ASK YOUR CHILD TO SHARE THEIR PASSWORD! THEIR PASSWORD IS PRIVATE!



Teachers or other users don't need access to passwords and will never ask your child to share it. If your school needs to access an account, they will always contact you first!

...ASK YOUR CHILD TO TALK PRIVATELY! ONLINE LESSONS ARE NORMAL LESSONS!



Teachers will never ask to talk privately or ask to speak with your child in secret. Discussions with teachers will be the same as they are in class.

...ASK YOUR CHILD TO CHANGE APPS OR WEBSITE.

Teachers will never ask your child to meet them on another app or website suddenly. We will only ever suggest websites which we have checked are reliable. These will be posted on Tapestry or Google Classroom.



...ARRANGE TO MEET YOUR CHILD OFFLINE. REMEMBER, THESE ARE SCHOOL LESSONS!



Even when schools are not using remote learning, teachers will never arrange to meet your child offline.

TOP TIPS - How to ensure your child is safe online

Try to support your child during learning time so you can see what they are doing. Ask them to work in an open space, not in a bedroom or behind closed doors.

If anything feels wrong or different, contact your school immediately.

Have regular conversations about online safety and encourage them to share their online experiences with you.

Don't rely on internet filters to monitor websites. Ensure children leave their google classroom when the teacher leaves—this platform is not for socialising afterwards.
