Key Information

Start Time: The gates open at 8:40a.m. by the vehicle entrance to allow children to come straight up and enjoy "Magic Breakfast". At 8:55a.m. the gates will be closed and children will need to be signed in. *Remember: the sooner you are in, the warmer your breakfast will be. ☺*

End Time: The gates open for home time at 3pm. The children will exit via the vehicle entrance as they did last term. We are the second LKS2 class to be dismissed. Mrs Robinson's go out first, closely followed by our class. Please can I remind parents to enter the area where the children are stood to come and collect them and not outside of the fenced area.

PE: Our class have PE on **Monday** and **Friday** afternoon. This term, we will also have an extra PE session on a **Thursday** morning as we are very lucky to be having a cricket coach come into school to teach us. PE uniform is trainers, navy or black leggings, jogging bottoms or shorts, their red school shirt or PE top and their school sweatshirt if it's cold. *Hoodies are not appropriate due to possibility of the hood being caught in equipment.*

Forest School: Forest school will take place each **Thursday** afternoon. Children should bring in **wellies/old trainers** in a named bag. Please ensure that children have a **waterproof coat** because forest school will take place in all weather conditions.

Water Bottles: It is important for children to be kept hydrated throughout the day. Please ensure that they have a drinks bottle labelled with their name, which can be kept in class. It is not always possible for us to have a supply of clean cups kept in the classroom for the children to use.

Coat and Jumper: Please ensure your child has a **school jumper** and a warm **waterproof coat** in school daily, as playtimes are outside in all weathers. Also, our classroom will still be well ventilated with all the windows open.
