How to report your safeguarding concerns about...

A child...

Report it to the designated safeguarding lead (DSL) or deputy, by:

- If child is immediate danger or risk of harm, report immediately, verbally to the DSL or deputy
- Record all safeguarding concerns factually on CPOMs, within 24 hours and alert all DSLs.

If it's a mental health concern, report it by:

- As above.
- Report to DSL regarding referral to specialized support depending on which threshold, if any, is met.
- Mental Health concerns relating to a child can be completed on an MHST referral form and given to Becki Howlett, DSL.

... A member of staff

If it **meets the 'harm' threshold**:

- Report concerns about a member of staff or volunteer to the headteacher immediately, verbally and followed up in writing.
- Report concerns about the headteacher to the chair of governors, Helen Curel, by contacting them via email hcurel@oakfieldcepri.iow.sch.uk

If there's a conflict of interest in reporting to the headteacher, go to the local authority designated officer (LADO): Fiona Armfield You can contact them by: child.protection@hants.gov.uk

If it's a **'low-level' concern**:

- Report your concern in writing to the headteacher.
