What does the Service do?

Support to:

- Identify, evaluate and meet a child/young person's Neurodivergent needs
- Develop awareness, understanding and compassion for Neurodivergent needs
- Engage all adults with a child/young person's Neurodivergent needs
- Secure successful strategies that enable a child/young person to develop confidence, security, and resilience around their Neurodivergence.

What will the support look like?

- Completion of a Neurodiversity Profiling Tool
- Ongoing support through 1:1 consultations
- Access to partner Services
- Revolving door ethos – support for as long as needed
- Strategies/advice/coaching/mentoring/training

What is the Neurodiversity Profiling Tool?

- The ND Profiling Tool is a visual document that assesses nine developmental strands of a child or young person aged 0-19.

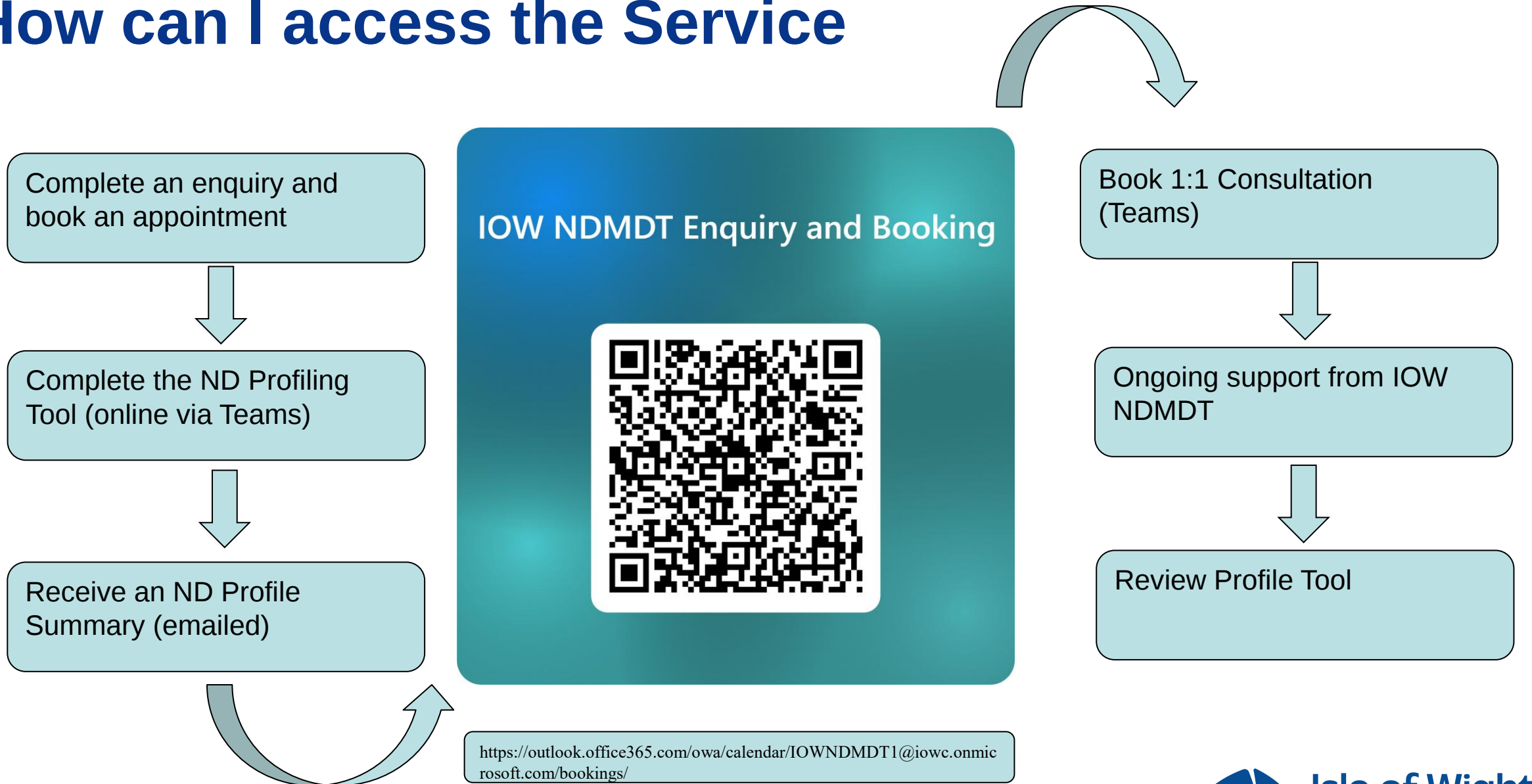
