Hello everyone!

It seems unbelievable to be saying this but your children have now almost completed their first year at Oakfield CE Primary School and what a wonderful year it has been!

Our learning for this half term will be focused on Superheroes and Space!

In English, we will be sharing these books together – Ten Little Superheroes by Michael Brownlow and The Way Back Home by Oliver Jeffers.

As a class group, we have now completed the teaching of Basics 2 and Basics 3 of Supersonic Phonic Friends – our phonics programme. So, this half term, the children will be continuing to revisit, use and apply all their knowledge in a wide variety of writing opportunities in order for them to demonstrate what they can do independently. We will also be working on our stamina to write some super sentences, remembering capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

In Maths, we will be continuing to explore number bonds to 10, adding and subtracting up to 10 and looking at practical number problems together. We will also continue to build on our subitising skills and numerical patterns such as odd and even numbers and double facts.

Your contributions to your child's learning journey are greatly appreciated so please keep in touch via Tapestry and I am always available if you would like a catch up after school or have a query!

Our class worship will be on Tuesday 14th July at 2:45pm in the hall. We hope you can make it.
